Music

MCCC requests that you treat printed music with care and respect, particularly purchased music that is part of the Masterworks collection. Music that is copied can be marked up as desired since it is not returned at the end of the season. Purchased music, however, should be marked up only with pencil that can be easily erased. Highlighting one's part is not permitted. Excessively marked up or highlighted printed music cannot be reused and results in unnecessary expense to the choir. Members are always free to purchase your own copies if you so desire.

Expectations

We are far more than just a collection of voices; we are an ensemble. Choral singing is a very powerful art form because of the way so many diverse voices and expressive feelings meld into one unified sound. To accomplish this, please follow these simple expectations:

- Arrive on time. Return quickly after the mid-rehearsal break.
- Inform Michael Holmes if you must miss a rehearsal, arrive late, or leave early.
- Wear a mask if not vaccinated. Stay home if you have any signs of illness.
- Do not miss more than three rehearsals.
- Keep talking to a minimum during rehearsals. Be attentive.
- Have a pencil ready to lightly mark your music.
- Take time at home to work on your music. (Audio files will be available to help with this.)
- Be friendly with other Chorale members.
- Volunteer to help the Chorale where needed.
